

MDG1: Eradicate extreme poverty and hunger: Eritrea's Goal is not just to eradicate 'extreme' poverty but do away with poverty once and for all. And it is evident that Eritrea will achieve food security in the near future.



MDG 2: Achieve universal primary education:

-More than 87% of Eritrean children have been able to gain access to education.

MDG 3: Promote gender equality and empower women

- the participation of girls in education is almost 50% of that of male students
- Eritrea is the only country in Africa that made FGM illegal
- the equality of women is secured under the law
- women in Eritrea have equal economic opportunities and they participate equal in all the economic and service rendering sectors

MDG 4: Reduce child mortality

- 99% success was scored in child vaccination
- Polio, measles andwere completely eradicated
