

Farm plots belonging to 200 needy farmers in Geza-Dungur and Adi-Tesfaliul administrative areas, Areza sub-zone, have been cultivated through tractors, according to Mr. Mihretu Araya, expert in seed fertilization in the Agriculture Ministry's branch in the sub-zone.
