Speaking at the seminar, Mr. Berhane Gebrehiwet, Embassy executive, explained that the Eritrean people and their leadership have made remarkable

He further pointed out that the country is in a position to lay the necessary infrastructural facilities for investment despite the “no peace no war situation.”
