Agordat, 18 January 2013 – The Education Ministry's branch in Agordat sub-zone called on the inhabitants to extend a helping hand towards promoting Adult Education. It made the call at a meeting conducted with the inhabitants of Ad-Qeyi'e village during which it was noted that there exist 48 stations for the program, which impact has become significant, especially among those leading nomadic lifestyle.
