In a meeting with the inhabitants of Habero-Tselim, Habero-Tsaeda and Mezret administrative areas, he explained that the Government is doing its level best to improve the people's standard of living and achieve food security. To this end, the Administrator called on the inhabitants to make optimum use of the existing natural resources and farming plots.
