The summer training which is being provided in Kidus Poulos and Erdi Awet schools in Dekemhare as well as in Sema'atat and Denden Secondary Schools in Asmara focuses on language, sport, administrative, leadership and computer courses.

Ms. Meriem Saleh and Sister Letichirstos Ogubayesus, both preschool teachers, said that the course which emphasizes on close relations among teachers and parents is helpful in their workplace. Similarly, another teacher, Mr. Mahmud Ja'efer said that the training is playing due role in enhancing their knowledge and experience.
