Accordingly, about 742 hectares belonging to a total of 1,332 martyrs' families have been cultivated through popular campaign, while residential houses of 45 families of martyrs renovated. New residential houses of 11 martyrs' families in Hantsetsa and Darhlase were also built through the participation of the farming community.
